**Under this agreement for 2019
Weir State School will receive**

\$460,184*

This funding will be used to ensure :

- Every student achieves success in reading from Prep – 3. NAPLAN (NMS – National Minimum Standard Year 3 - 95 % / Upper 2 bands ...increase of 25%)
- Every student achieves success in writing Prep - 3. NAPLAN (NMS - National Minimum Standard year 3 - 95 %/ Upper 2 Bandsincrease of 25%)
- Reculturing of whole school approach to Positive Behaviour and Learning (PBL) Reduce SDAs by 20% schoolwide
- Building strategic vision for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) and NAPLAN online implementation

Our initiatives include:

- Implementation of the 4 lesson sequence reading strategy to lift reading levels across Prep – 3 and monitor data of individual students (Sharrat)
- Implementation phonemic awareness program across lower years to improve writing (Heggarty)
- Positive Behaviour and Learning Coach to support student engagement across school lowering SDAs (School Disciplinary Absences) through high expectation methodology (Sarraf)
- Engage STEM / NAPLAN online coordinator 3 days per week and purchase of ICT hardware in readiness for NAPLAN online

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- Engaging a lower years reading coach to improve reading from Prep – 3 (\$110 000)
- Engaging a lower years phonemic awareness coach to improve writing (\$110 000)
- Engaging a behaviour support coach to improve Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) systems (\$ 100 000)
- Implement STEM strategy and NAPLAN online readiness for 2020 (\$ 140 000)
